Travel Tips and Info from the TSA

Excerpts from letter from Kimberly A. Walton, Assistant Administrator, Office of Civil Rights and Liberties, Ombudsman, and Traveler Engagement

Arrive at least two hours early for domestic and three hours early for international flights, to give yourself plenty of time to get through security screening. For general information about what to expect during security screening, you may contact the TSA Contact Center at (866) 289-9673 or email at TSA-ContactCenter@tsa.dhs.gov. The TSA Contact Center has representatives available on weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Eastern Time and on weekends/holidays from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Eastern Time. Automated information is available in 12 languages. Travelers who are deaf or hard of hearing may use a relay service to contact the TSA Contact Center (Federal Relay 711).

TSA also offers the TSA Cares helpline. I encourage anyone who may need additional assistance during the security screening process, travelers with disabilities or medical conditions, and travelers who have concerns about the screening process to contact TSA Cares at least 72 hours before travel.

TSA Cares agents have received training to provide callers with specific information about the specialized screening needs in a variety of circumstances. In addition, you may provide a TSA Cares agent with your flight itinerary, and they will coordinate assistance to be specifically available for you with a Passenger Support Specialist (PSS) and/or customer service manager at the airport. Even if you do not provide your itinerary beforehand, you may ask for a PSS or supervisor at the checkpoint.

The PSS program was created to assist travelers at the checkpoint, and Passenger Support Specialists receive specialized training, including how to assist and communicate with individuals with disabilities as well as best practices on interactions with travelers from various cultures and communities. While TSA recommends contacting TSA Cares to set up PSS assistance in advance, our goal is to have a PSS in the vicinity of every checkpoint to provide assistance as needed and resolve traveler-related screening concerns on the ground, as quickly as possible.

Any traveler who needs assistance or is concerned about his or her screening may ask for a Supervisory Transportation Security Officer or a PSS at any time.

Travelers or their companions may call TSA Cares toll-free at (855) 787-2227. The hours of operation for the TSA Cares helpline are 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Eastern Time from Monday to Friday, and 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Eastern Time on weekends/ holidays. Travelers who are deaf or hard of hearing may e-mail TSA-ContactCenter@tsa.dhs.gov or may use a relay service to contact TSA Cares (Federal Relay 711).

You may also download a Notification Card from www.tsa.gov/travel/special-procedures, which allows you to discreetly notify the Transportation Security Officer of your disability, medical condition, or other circumstance that requires assistance. This card, however, does not exempt you from screening.

Fredecia continues to check in with regards to her health as well as her husband's. They are hoping to be back in attendance soon. One of our original supporters passed away this year. "Mr. Bob" rarely missed a meeting since he joined in 2004. He was always quick to welcome a newcomer, share the special soap he thought was essential to ostomy skin care or share some other interesting gadget he had found. He will be greatly missed.

We spoke of possible presentations and presenters for the coming year. Cindy will be working to coordinate these speakers each month. To end the year, Nick Gritzai the President and CEO of Cymed led us through a wonderful presentation on his products. Nick began by telling us that Cymed products were designed in the mid 80's by an ostomate who was not happy with products that were on the market at that time. The thin flexible elastic 1/1000" polyurethane breathable waterproof "micro skin" product was patented.

Nick learned the business from the ground up and bought the company from the owner when she decided to retire. He has learned that one of the main challenges for ostomates is to have a correct fit. Part of making this fit is to determine if your stoma is flush, recessed or protruding. Cymed offers a hydrocolloid washer that can help with recessed stomas. Nick was also very excited about a new HTLA (high tack low absorption) ring that will be available soon. This ring may be helpful with flush and recessed stomas.

Nick described the unique properties of Ile-sorb which turns liquid output from ileostomy into crystal and can help prevent leakage. Although there are similar products on the market; none are as effective as Ile-sorb! With a new PhD Biomedical Engineer on their team, Cymed is making many improvements to their products. 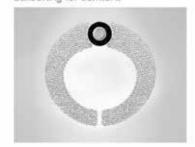


