At the next meeting of the Board of Directors, we will be discussing our project that will involve communicating with the home health care workers in the Houston area. As you may know, the numbers of days that ostomates stay in hospitals have been greatly shortened from the number in prior years. This is one reason the number of requests for hospital visits from our support group has decreased. Many patients may go to rehab or may be seen by home health care workers. The former national organization before it ceased to exist had recommended that this will be the time to make contact with patients who may need the services of our support group. We now have a list to work from and we are preparing a letter to send to these workers to see how we can best serve them and their patients.

In December, a nominating committee will be formed to nominate people for permanent board of director positions. At this time, there are two positions that will need to be filled. The election of directors will be by members at the various meetings in May of 2007. In June 2007, the board of directors will meet and elect the officers for the next few years. We hope that you will consider serving if you are contacted by the committee.

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
